## Terms & Conditions of Play

### Etiquette

- Maximum of 4 persons per group.
- Every person must have their own set of golf clubs – no sharing. Sets are available to hire from the pro shop.
- Please use toilet facilities provided in the clubhouse (1<sup>st</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> holes) and on the left side of the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole.
- Please be respectful of other people on the golf course and keep noise to acceptable levels.
- A neat and tidy standard of dress is required.

### Speed of Play

- Please keep up with the group in front of you. It should take a group of 4 people only 4 hours to play the full 18 holes. Any group on track for a time over 4.5 hours will be considered slow and asked to increase speed of play.
- Slow groups must give way to faster players behind them.
- It is at the sole discretion of the starter to determine the tees of the day. It may be a requirement that on busy days groups will be asked to play off the white tees.

### Golf Carts

- Cart hire is completely at the discretion of Queenstown Golf Club staff.
- All drivers must have a current recognised full drivers licence.
- Maximum of two people per cart at all times. No riding on the back of golf carts.
- All 'on course' golf cart instructions must be followed.
- No smoking in golf carts.
- No driving close to tees or greens, no skidding, no bumping into other carts, no driving into bunkers.
- Any damage to carts or the golf course is the responsibility of the hirer and they will be liable for all costs of repair.
- In wet weather/slippery conditions carts should be driven with caution.

### Alcohol

- Intoxicated people will not be allowed on the course and will be asked to leave the premises.

### Weather

- We cannot predict the weather. Once a green fee has been paid it is non-refundable. If course conditions become un-playable (determined by Queenstown Golf Club staff) then staff will arrange an alternate time to complete the round.

Anyone in breach of the above terms and conditions will be warned and successive breaches will result in the group being asked to leave the golf course.
